### **FISH DAY**

Fish Day depends on how much our Hupačasath Fisherman catch on Friday and Saturday.

If there is a fair amount caught, fish will be distributed on Sunday June 7<sup>th</sup> in the morning. If we don't reach this fair amount, as per the *Opetchesaht Fisheries Law (1992)* Elders & Disabled will be taken care of first.

The Fish Day Policy, labelled as '*Opetchesaht Fisheries Law*'\*, was distributed to all membership in the meeting package that was sent out prior to May 28<sup>th</sup> Community Meeting. This is the policy we are following for any fish day related activities. Please note on page 9 of the *Opetchesaht Fisheries Law* and read very carefully on what Fish Day is and how fish is to be distributed.

- The ability to work with electronic data systems such as computers and tablets
