Our Fisheries Department wants to give you the heads that we may have another FRESH halibut distribution next weekend. With fresh fish it is uncertain when the boat returns with the harvest. We will do our best to keep people updated. We ask people save the date for next Saturday April 29th.

Can't make it?

A completed authorization form or signed letter will be required and can be presented to fish day staff at the time of pick-up. We won't be offering picking up a frozen share later again. So pick up your fresh fish this day or be without.

Submitting an authorization form

You must submit **your own** authorization form to Front Desk or pass it off to the person you designated. Make sure the person you designate to pick up knows they are picking up for you.

Sale of the fish is not permitted.

Fluoride Varnish

- Should be applied to your child's teeth up to four times a year
- Helps prevent cavities by making the outside layer of the teeth stronger
- Can start as soon as your child has teeth
- Teeth are wiped dry and the varnish is applied with a small brush
- Is safe
- Takes only seconds to apply

Sealants

- Help protect teeth from getting cavities
- Deep pits and grooves on the top of back teeth are sealed
- Do not require freezing
- Are easy to do
- Last a long time



Temporary Fillings (ART)

- Treat tooth decay in children as young as one year of age
- Don't require freezing
- Are pain free
- Are done quickly
- Keep the tooth healthy until the child is old enough to have a permanent filling
- May reduce the need for dental treatment in hospital under a general anesthetic
