Duties and Responsibilities:

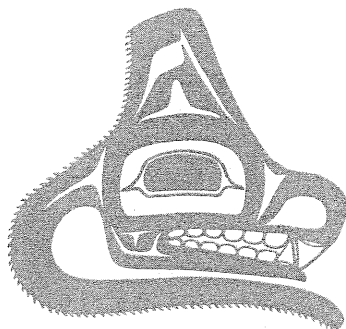
- Ability to inspire program participants and create a positive atmosphere.

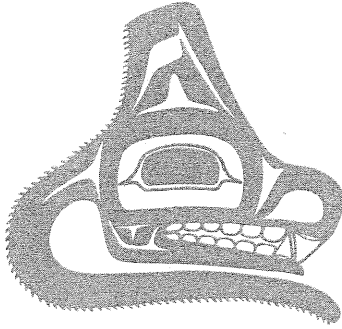
